Texas Musician Gets Chart Action Abroad

Chet Daniels' self titled last CD, "Chet" was released December 2006 and last month he signed a deal with Comstock Records for distribution in Europe and Australia. The eleventh song on the CD, *What am I Worth*, is the first song to receive chart action. It is now #17 in the Netherlands.

His CD released in 2005, *"Back from Blue,"* could be described as country rock. This latest release has been described as "a mixture of country, blues and swamp pop." Both were recorded and mixed at the famous SugarHill Recording Studios in Houston where Chet has had a long and creative relationship.

Back from Blue was his first solo album, but this latest CD has a collection of musicians
